## Heidelberg Catechism - Lord's Day 44

### Q & A 113 What is the aim of the tenth commandment?

A. That not even the slightest desire or thought contrary to any one of God's commandments should ever arise in our hearts.

Rather, with all our hearts  
we should always hate sin  
and take pleasure in whatever is right.

### Q & A 114 But can those converted to God obey these commandments perfectly?
