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## Questions for the Week

2. If I found myself in Paul and Silas' prison cell, would my response look more like praise or complaint? What does my daily attitude reveal about where my joy is really found?
3. Who is "listening to my songs in prison"? In the middle of hardship, how are my words, attitudes, and actions shaping the witness I have before unbelievers?
4. When I defend myself or stand up for my rights, am I motivated by God's glory, the good of others, and the advance of the gospel—or by personal pride and revenge?

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
