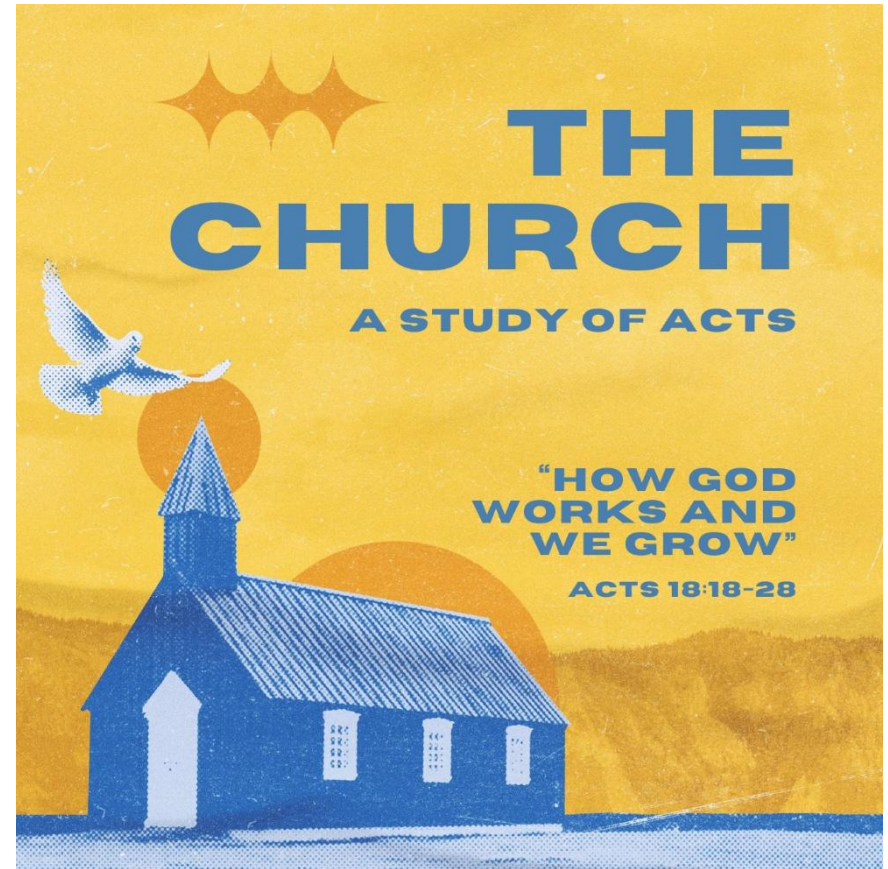
Pray for **Justin Karsten's nephew Kaden** who recently joined the Marines and left for boot camp last week.
