Pray for **Megan Bader** as she is moving to Wisconsin in the coming week. Pray for peace in both her and Joan.

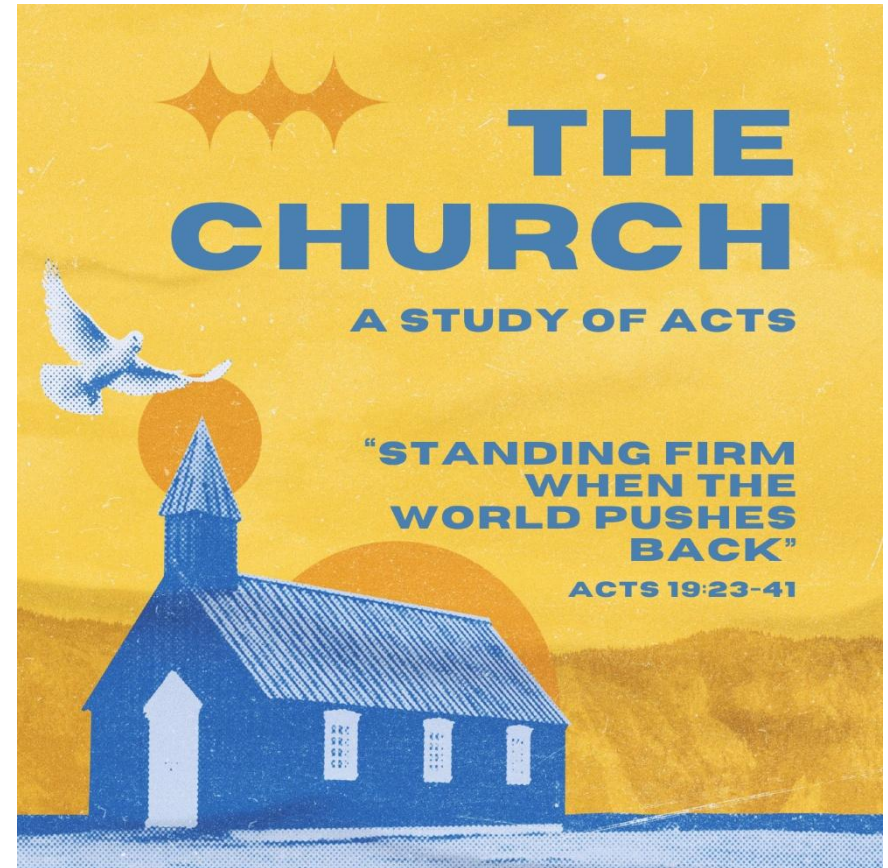
Pray for **Joan Bader's stepmother** as she moved to an assisted living facility in GR and had to leave her home of 85 years in Wisconsin.
