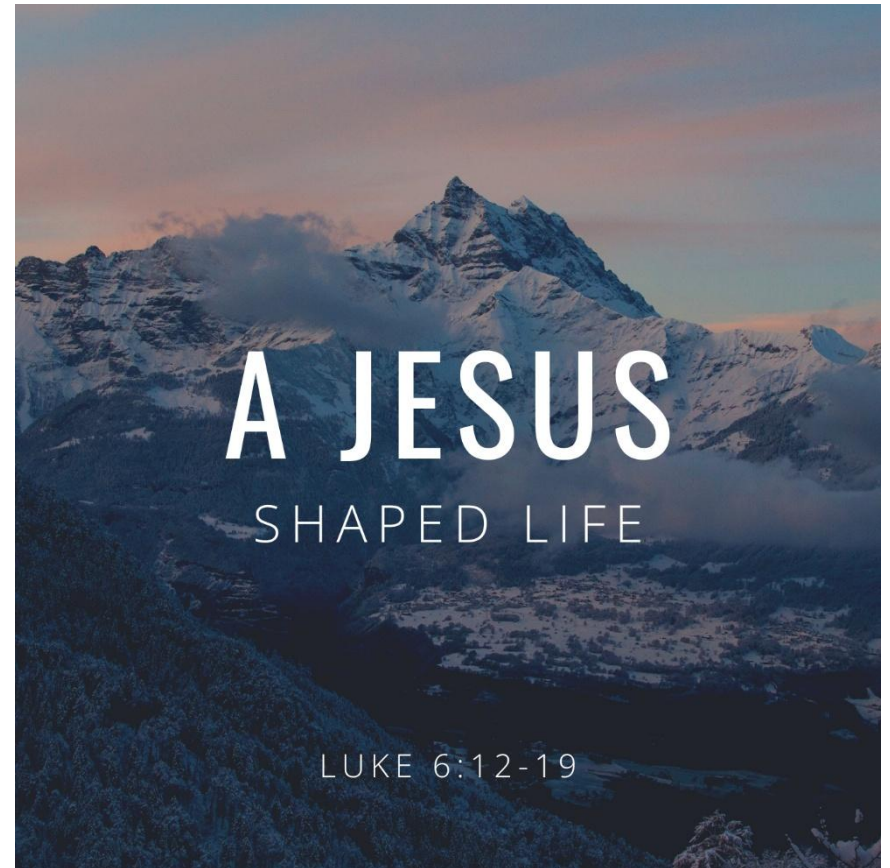
Pray for **Mike Weaver’s stepfather, Herb**, as he recently suffered a heart attack. Pray for his strength and health.
